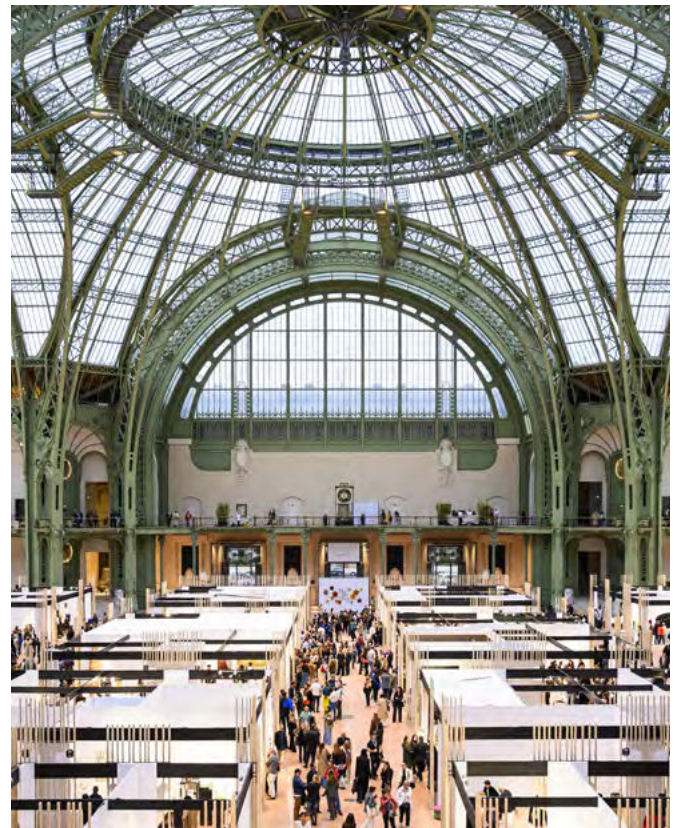

## RÉVÉLATIONS: THE INTERNATIONAL FINE CRAFT AND CREATION BIENNIAL RETURNS TO THE GRAND PALAIS IN MAY 2027

After a 2025 edition that brought together more than 550 creators from around the world and over 45,000 visitors (+24% compared to the previous edition), the international fine craft and creation biennial organised by Ateliers d'Art de France – the professional organisation for fine crafts – will return from 19 to 23 May 2027, at the Grand Palais, in Paris.

At the heart of Nave and on the balconies, fine craft workers of excellence, creators, artwork manufactures, art galleries, as well as renowned institutions and schools... will unveil their creations, unique, never-before-seen works created especially for the fair. For this edition, Révélations has renewed its scenography, celebrating the lightness of paper through an ethereal and inspired setting. The biennial is once again taking over the balconies to welcome an ever-growing number of

exhibitors. It establishes Paris as the epicentre of contemporary creation through the international exhibition Le Banquet, a true dialogue between fine crafts from around the world, and a programme of conferences dedicated to the current challenges of the sector.

The biennial brings creators together with a knowledgeable French and international audience: collectors, connoisseurs of exceptional creations and fine craftsmanship and prescribers, from architecture to hospitality, gastronomy, retail, and the luxury world.

Free, independent, uncompromising and unformatted, Révélations has become, over seven editions, far more than a fair: **a living manifesto for contemporary creation in fine crafts on an international scale.**

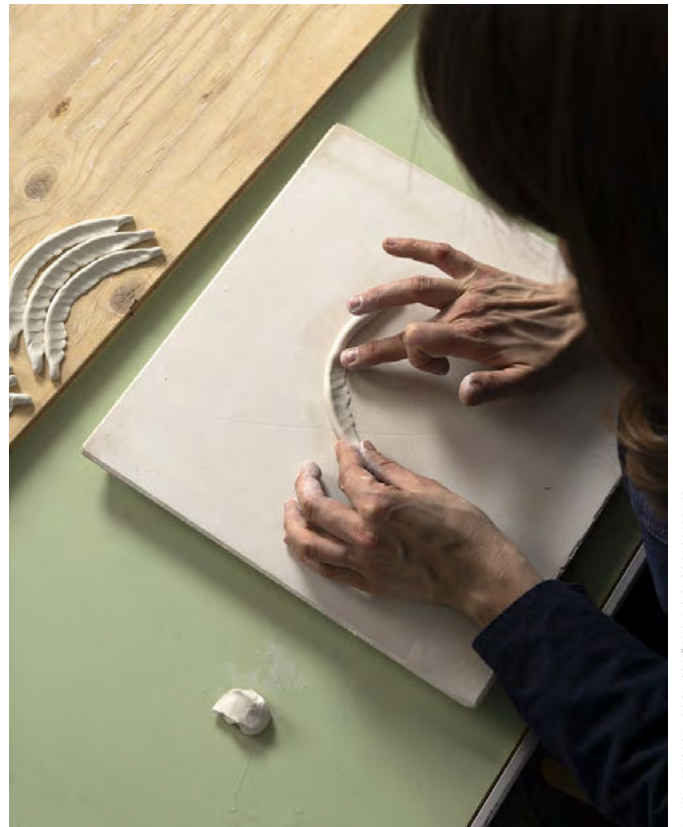
Each edition of Révélations is embodied by an exceptional work, the signature of a creator of outstanding craftsmanship, to be discovered exclusively at the event. For the first time in its history, the biennial honours **an artwork created specifically for the event**, combining two materials: textile and ceramics.

In her workshop in Bergen, Norway — a former sardine factory on a pier — German-born creator **Daniela Bergschneider brings materials into dialogue**: porcelain and nylon come together to create body sculptures and installations. Hybrid, intriguing and fascinating, **Gewächs VI is a modular sculpture that required three months of intensive work**. It brings together hundreds of small, uniform porcelain elements, each handmade and bearing the fingerprints of their creator, with a hand-dyed nylon fabric using the traditional Japanese Shibori technique. The porcelain elements create an inner «bone-like» system, while the textile holds everything together, like a skin. The final composition emerges through processes of draping and arrangement, rather than following a predetermined form. Both ancient and futuristic, organic and constructed, this sculpture brings together materials rich in associations, leaving room for ambiguity.

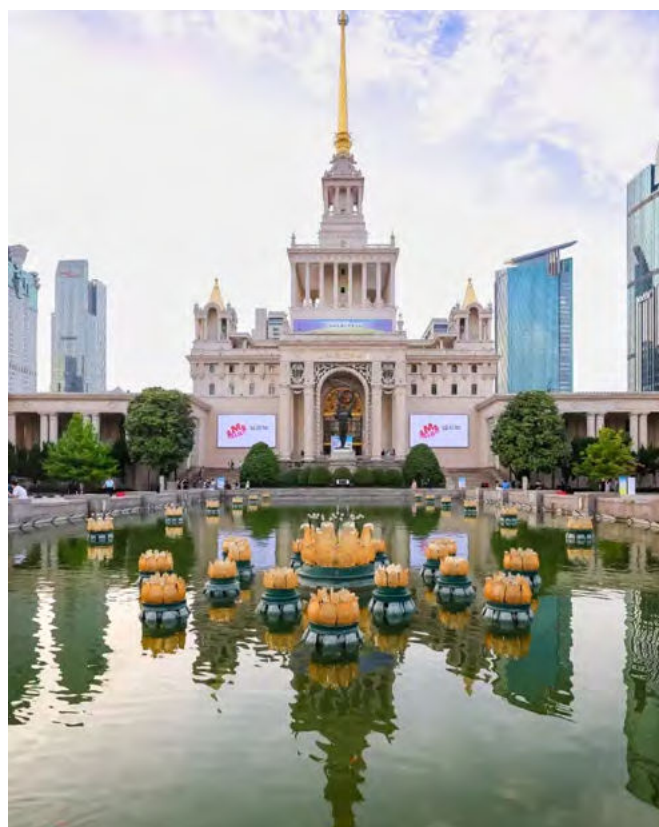


**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: REVELATIONS CHINA, NOVEMBER 19–23, 2026, SHANGHAI**

Building on the success of its first edition in September 2024 — which brought together 126 fine craft workers from 16 countries and presented 500 unique works — the second edition of **Revelations China will be held in Shanghai from November 19 to 23, 2026.**

Ateliers d'Art de France, owner of the Révélations brand, and Global ACE Group, exclusive organiser of Revelations China, are pleased to continue this collaboration. As the first international edition of Révélations, Revelations China is positioned as a living platform for contemporary dialogue — open, plural and professional. A major economic appointment, the event fosters quality exchanges between creators, collectors and cultural institutions, while offering visibility to local and international exhibiting artisans seeking to access the Asian and Chinese markets. For its second edition, Revelations China sets up in China's economic capital, during Shanghai Art Week, at the heart of international buyer and collector flows.

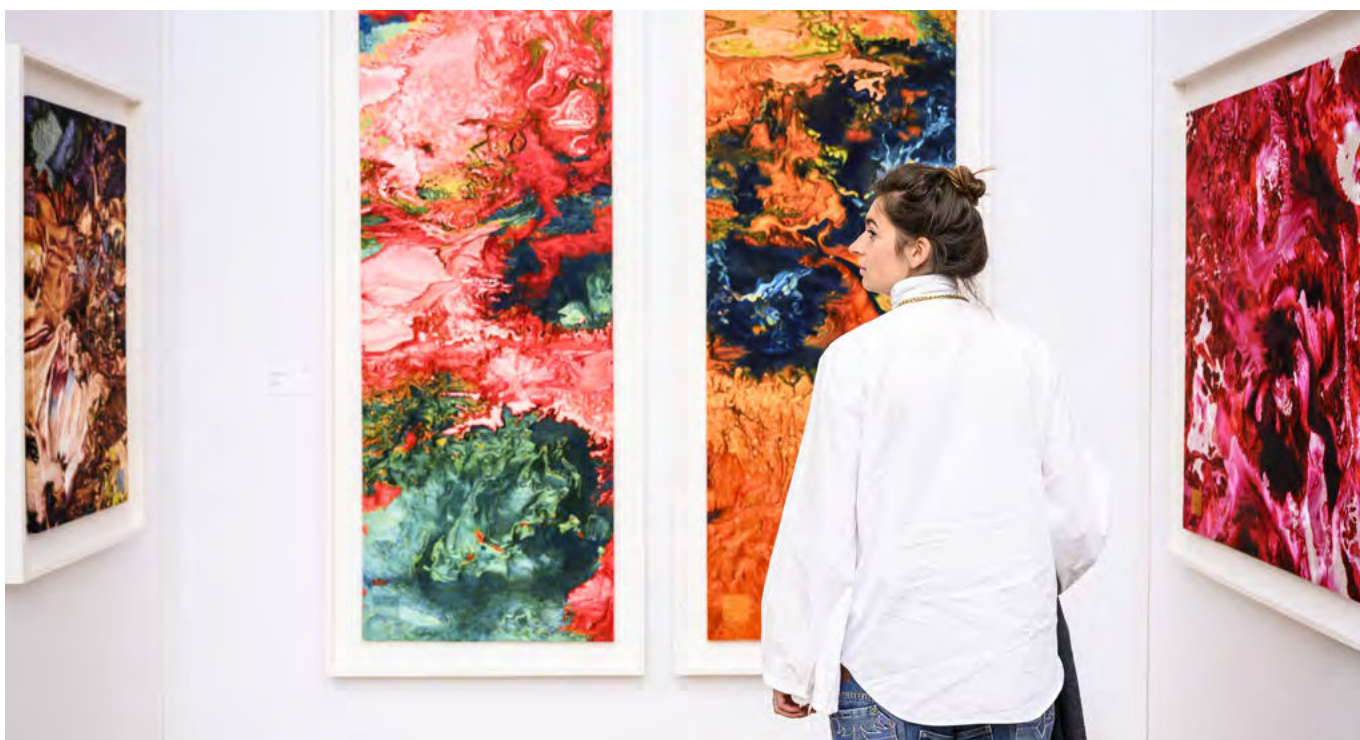
**ABOUT ATELIERS D'ART DE FRANCE**
